

## **Service Projects: Spring Grants and Easter Shoes Update**

Each spring Christ Child Society of Pasadena supports our partner parish schools by granting funds to help support children in need during their second semester of school. This includes:

- funding lunch for individual children
- graduation fees
- First Communion fees and clothes
- Confirmation retreats
- registration fees for the fall semester

Thanks to the generosity of our members, **CCS Pasadena was able to contribute \$28,241 to 16 schools, which impacts the lives of more than 150 students.** 



We also raised \$19,000 through the Easter Shoes appeal that allowed us to give 225 gift cards. For the first time ever, we were able to increase the gift card amount from \$25.00 to \$50.00.

The Christ Child Society membership is truly remarkable for their commitment to the children in the San Gabriel Valley. **Thanks to you**, we keep children connected to Catholic Education and the nurturing, loving, environment our parish schools provide. Mary Virginia Merrick would be pleased!

#### **5-Minute Hummus Recipe**

Yield: 4 generous cups Time: 10 minutes (they say 5, I say 10)

#### Ingredients:

- ¼ garlic clove
- Juice of 1 lemon, about ¼ cup
- 1 (16 oz) jar tahini
- 1 tbs kosher salt
- 1 tsp ground cumin
- 1 to 1 ½ cups ice water
- 2 (15 oz) cans chickpeas, drained and rinsed

#### Preparation:

Step 1: Drop the ¼ garlic clove into a food processor and add the lemon juice. Put the tahini on top, making sure to scrape it all out of the container, and add the salt and cumin. Process until the mixture looks peanut-buttery, about 1 minute. Stream in the ice water, a little at a time, with the motor running. Process just until the mixture is smooth and creamy and lightens to the color of dry sand.

Step 2: Add the chickpeas and process for about 3 minutes, scraping the sides of the bowl as you go, until the chickpeas are completely blended, and the hummus is smooth and uniform in color.
