As we begin our new 2022-2023 year, we are always looking for additional supporters, volunteers, and Helping Angels. TREASURES

The **Treasures Program** is a Manners or Etiquette Class. The program is a seven-week course – two hours per class. Each class addresses a subject such as making introductions, dining manners and thank you notes. Our members work with fifth and sixth graders at local parochial schools. LAYETTES

The Layette volunteers assemble and provide new mothers with some basic needs for Infants. Volunteers meet at St. Andrew Pastoral Center to assemble the layettes. We are thankful to have devoted knitters in our CCS who make blankets, booties, and caps that are included in each layette. The layettes are distributed to many area parishes, hospitals, pregnancy help centers, children's services, and Catholic charity organizations. PALS (Pairs and Learn Session)

As **PALS volunteers**, our members read aloud to the children in grades K-3 at St Andrew and Nativity Catholic schools. Parish Ambassadors and Service Projects

Service Projects are administered through volunteer members who are Parish Ambassadors and act as liaisons to designated parish schools in the San Gabriel Valley. Communicating with the schools' principals throughout the year, our ambassadors identify the needs of the most underprivileged children at the schools and invite the principals to submit requests for funds to support those needs. As a result, our Service Projects program (Christmas Stocking Fund & Easter Shoes) pays for items such as uniforms, registration, sacramental fees, and lunch for the neediest children at the schools. From Our Spiritual Advisor

Dear Members of the Christ Child Society of Pasadena,

Greetings in Christ! I hope you all had a joyful Christmas and New Year and are healthy and staying strong.

I write this to you after just having returned from a week visiting family in Cuba. It is always a challenge to travel there because some of the things we typically take for granted (electricity, water, toilet paper!) are not always available.

Sometimes they are and sometimes they aren't. This year there was water, but electricity went out daily. It helps me a great deal to make this annual trip, however. It is wonderful to see my extended family and to bring them needed supplies as well as visit the parish there and bring things like candles and incense, but it is also serves as a good reminder to me. So often we simply take so much that we have for granted. We live in this wonderful country of the United States, and it is easy to forget that we have been greatly blessed. Much of the world does not have what we have.

This is what the Christ Child Society is all about: helping the needy especially the littlest ones among us. Your work of charity makes a huge difference in the lives of so many families.

We are about to begin Lent once again. Ash Wednesday this year falls on February 22nd. I urge you to start thinking now about your upcoming Lenten resolutions. Most of us were brought up with the idea of "giving up" something for Lent. This is a very worthwhile practice as it is a means of penance and mortification as well as self-sacrifice. I strongly recommend it. But also, think about "doing" something special for Lent as well. This can be using the money we might save on chocolate, ice cream, liquor or whatever we give up, and give it to charity. In this case, I recommend the Christ Child Society as that charity so you can make a difference in the lives of others.

In addition, I strongly urge you to make some resolutions regarding your spiritual life. Lent is a time of renewal. So, resolve to pray more daily, to attend daily Mass, to go to Confession regularly, to pray the Stations of the Cross at your parish, to do more spiritual reading, to participate in the beautiful ceremonies and Masses of Holy Week, etc. In this way when Easter arrives, we, hopefully, are better persons to rejoice in the Lord's resurrection.

Yummy Cornbread (aka Trader Joe's cornbread!) For each box of mix you will need:
