## From our Spiritual Advisor....



Dear Members of the Christ Child Society of Pasadena,

Greetings in Christ! I hope you all had a joyful Christmas and New Year, and are healthy and staying strong.

Soon after you receive this letter, we will be celebrating Ash Wednesday (on March 2nd) and the beginning of Lent followed by the joyous Season of Easter. It is truly a time for spiritual renewal. March of 2022 is also the 2-year mark since the beginning of the Coronavirus pandemic. It is truly hard to believe that we have lived with this for 2 years now. I recall well March of 2020 and the terrible pain of being forced to close the church and school for weeks. Then we were allowed back in briefly only to **then** be told we had to worship outside for months until December when that order was declared unconstitutional, and we were allowed back indoors for regular worship. It is truly amazing to think of what we have all endured these last two years. But, as a people of faith, we always have hope, and now it seems like we are slowly coming out of the latest of the viral surges.

As we have all heard many times, what doesn't destroy us makes us stronger. I truly believe that, and I think it is very true regarding the experiences of this pandemic. Our daily Mass attendance, for example, is now so large that we no longer have daily Mass in the chapel. All Masses are held in the church in order to accommodate the bigger crowds. Sunday Mass attendance is actually higher now than it was pre-pandemic, and this is especially true of young large families. All this is an inspiration and a great sign of hope that we as Christians must be resilient in the face of multiple challenges.

It is this resilience which is also a characteristic of the founder of the Christ Child Society, the Servant of God Virginia Merrick. I marvel at the witness of this woman, who although faced with numerous limitations and challenges, rose above all of them in her determination to help poor children. It is that same spirit that must live in us today as members of this wonderful organization.

As we begin Lent, I recommend to you to follow the Church's traditional practices of penance, prayer and good works to assist in your spiritual renewal. The primary purpose of these, of course, is to help us become truly holy and pleasing in God's eyes. In addition to the customary abstinence on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays as well as fasting on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, it is also a time to take a good look at our spiritual lives and see where we can improve.

I would especially recommend during Lent cutting down on frivolous entertainment, online surfing, etc. and give more attention to our life of prayer. This would be an excellent time to pray the daily rosary, come to daily Mass, do the Stations of the Cross on Fridays, make a good Confession, and increase our spiritual reading.


As members of the Christ Child Society, you are already involved in wonderful works of charity but perhaps, we can go a little beyond the usual in this time and renew our dedication more fully.





## **Funding update**

#### Impacting the Lives of Children - Your Support Makes a Difference











Through your generosity, Christ Child has been able to positively change the lives of many children throughout our parish community. Last fall we funded \$47,249 for the following:

- \$38,917 to assist 126 students with books, registration, and technology fees.
- \$1940 to feed 12 students lunch.
- \$5300 to help 51 students with religious education
- \$1092 for uniforms for two students.

Our separate Emergency Grant program funded the following:

- \$1780 for vision exam and therapy by a developmental optometrist for one student.
- \$2045 for tuition and fees for one child who witnessed a profound tragedy and became an orphan.

Covid 19 has overwhelmed our parish schools and the needs of their families. Thank you for helping us make a difference in the lives of almost 200 children this past fall.
